


Dear Sirs;

I am in the process of purchasing additional service credit with the Public Employee's Retirement System (PERS) for the time I was employed by the County of Salem. They have advised that the County is 'unable to verify' certain periods of my employment and they have requested that I obtain from you a copy of my Civil Service History so that I may forward it to them as soon as possible.

I was first hired by the County of Salem on December 23, 1974 and this action was done on a CS-6 form.
